



What is the Role of a Key Contact Team Member?

The most important aspect of being a member of the Key Contact Team is having a positive one-on-one personal relationship with your State Representative. This relationship promotes a sense of mutual respect and familiarity.

Aside from maintaining this relationship, Key Contacts are called on to perform other functions as well. This could include any of the following:

- Attending in-district fundraisers for elected officials (either with your own funds or with funding from PHIL-PAC)
- Responding to "Call to Action" alerts when important votes effecting the real estate industry occur
- Visiting your House member in his/her district
- Becoming informed on legislative issues
- Attending occasional training sessions
- Developing REALTOR[®] support for your House member
- Volunteering on your House member's campaign
- Other activities that further promote a positive relationship
